Dear Mayor Opelt:

As you may recall, in June, 2008 we wrote to inform you of a planned transaction involving the ownership of Time Warner Cable Inc, the company which controls the cable television franchisee in your community. As described in our June, 2008 letter, Time Warner Inc. planned to fully divest its ownership interest in ("spin-off") Time Warner Cable Inc. ("TWC") leaving TWC as a separate publicly traded company.

I am pleased to advise you that the transaction closed on March 12, 2009 and that all the stock of TWC is now publicly traded. As we assured you before, the closing of this spin-off does not change the identity of the cable franchisee. Nor will it cause any change in our cable system services, policies or operations. We remain committed to providing the best in entertainment, information and communications services to our customers.
