These are programs just for students in grades 5-8. Sorry little kids.

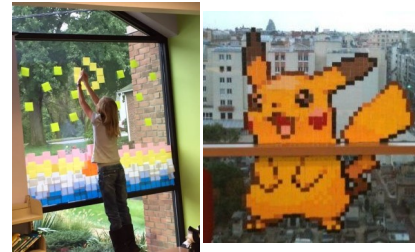
Registration is required for each challenge and attendance is limited. To register, stop by the library or call 419-287-4012.
